The City of Ririe is seeking public input as part of a Transportation Planning Study which is now underway. The City invites all residents, property and business owners, and those in the surrounding area that do business in the city and use city streets. Public input regarding City street issues, needs and how to best address them is requested. The City desires input from local farming, trucking, long haul trucking, school district, homeowners, businesses, bicycle enthusiasts and pedestrians.

The City obtained a grant from the Local Highway Technical Assistance Council to conduct the study. The grant is a 100% grant with no local match required. The study will position the City to move forward with a comprehensive long term improvement plan, assist in the maintenance of city streets and enable the City to better compete for state and federal transportation improvement dollars. A steering committee consisting of local, state, county, fire, police, city government and business leaders has been organized and is functioning as part of the study development and planning process. Professional consultants and city officials will be on hand to listen to and record your input.
